

TESTIM PRODUCT SPECIFIC TERMS

These Product-specific terms supplement the Tricentis General Terms of Use and supersede any conflicting terms for Testim:

- 1. Definitions.** The following additional definitions apply:
 - **“Project”** means a Customer account subgroup in which all User activity for that subgroup is performed, providing a way to organize, manage and execute test cases and suites; provided however that a “Project” may only be associated with one application technology (e.g. separate “Projects” for web-apps, iOS, and Android).
 - **“Run”** means a single test execution using Testim’s platform or command line interface tool with concurrent or parallel test executions each counting as a separate Run.
 - **“Run Limitation”** means the maximum number of Runs per month that you are entitled to use.
 - **“Virtual Machine” or “VM”** means a virtual environment for running parallel test executions, and is limited to the browsers/operating systems in the Testim documentation.
- 2. Run Limitations.** The applicable Run Limitation for paid subscriptions is set forth in the Order and will be calculated in the aggregate with respect to all Runs performed by Users. The number of VMs included in your Order represents the maximum number of parallel executions you can execute which also remain subject to the Run Limitation. If you exceed the applicable Run Limitation for a paid subscription, unless a **Run Limitation Exception** applies, you must pay for one or more increments of 500 Runs until the excess Runs have been covered. The price for each increment of 500 Runs will be 200% of the then-current list price (converted to a monthly price) of Testim Essential at the 500 Monthly Test Runs tier.

Run Limitation Exceptions:

 1. You may exceed the Run Limitation for a paid subscription by up to 50% during the first three months of an initial subscription term but not during a renewal term; or
 2. For paid renewal subscriptions, you may exceed the Run Limitation by up to 50% for a single month of a 12-month renewal term.
- 3. Testim Community Free Plan.** The Testim Community Free Plan is subject to the terms of the Limited Use Licenses section of Tricentis’s General Terms of Use. The Testim Community Free Plan is limited to a single web Project, a single iOS Project, a single Android Project, and a single VM, per Customer organization, with a Run Limitation of 500 web Runs and 50 combined iOS/Android Runs per month calculated in the aggregate with respect to all Runs performed by Users. If you exceed this Run Limitation, you must upgrade to a paid subscription or your account functionality will be limited.
